The Power of Effort: A Guide to GCSE Success



This guide explains why student effort is the most critical factor in improving GCSE grades between trial exams and the final results. Research shows that students who demonstrate specific effortful behaviours consistently see significant grade increases.

WHY EFFORT MATTERS: THE EVIDENCE



Effort Directly Improves Grades

55-60% of students improve their grades by one or more after trial exams.



96% of the students who raised their grade improved their effort and attendance after the trial exams.



The "Zero to Hero" Effect

Students who maximize effort after trials can improve by as much as 3 grades.

WHAT EFFORT LOOKS LIKE: THE 5 KEY ASPECTS



1. Being Organised

Having the right equipment, filing notes, and sticking to a revision timetable.



2. Completing All Classwork

Focusing on learning and work completion during every lesson is crucial.



3. Completing All Homework

All homework is a form of revision and is critical for improvement.



4. Using Feedback to Improve

Actively correcting work and using teacher advice to improve future assignments.



5. Attendance

Attending school every day, being on time, and going to all revision sessions.

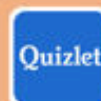

The space

PREPARE

- SPACES WITH ADULTS IN THE ROOM ARE GOOD
- A space needs a writing surface - to revise you have to write
- Wall space is helpful - many students like to pin common facts they need to know on the wall.
- Distractions (like phones) should be left in another room. If working on paper, even consider turning the wifi off.

How much revision?

PREPARE

- Students should be revising from now
- They should follow the 'Get Revising' revision timetable
 - Even split of time between subjects
 - Science and English are two exams
 - At least 4 x 25 minute chunks on a weekday
 - At least 8 x 25 minute chunks on a weekend day
 - Follow the normal in school timetable in the holidays (PE/PSHE becomes breaks)
 - Include 1 break day a week
- Revision timetables should be shared with parents

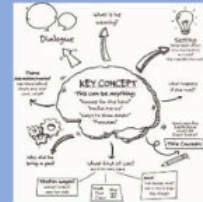

Flashcards

- Students should make their own
- 1 card = 1 Q&A
- Answers should contain **keywords** & explanations
- Then regular self testing
- Use the Leitner system
- Say answers out loud
- Also play 'guess the question'

Q: What is weight?

A: Weight is a measure of the force that gravity exerts on a mass.

- Because it is a force it's measured in Newtons
- Mass is measured in kg
- Weight in N = mass in kg x 9.81m/s^2
- Gravity attracts all masses to each other

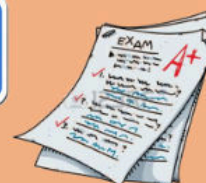

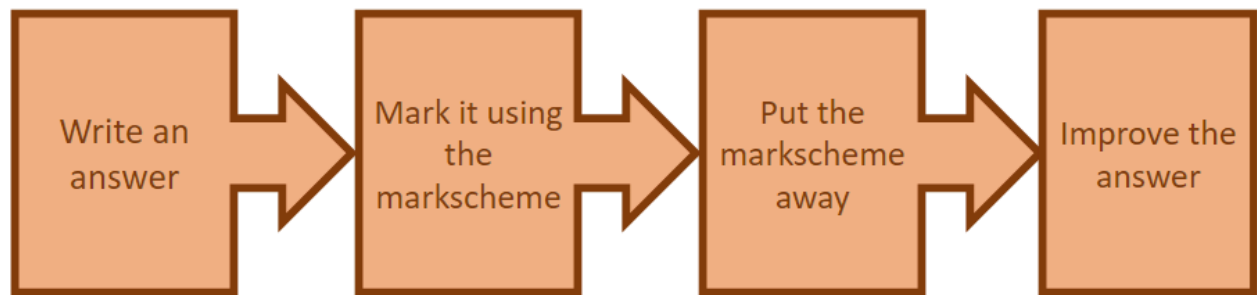
The Leitner system

A way of using flashcards to test the things you know the least more often



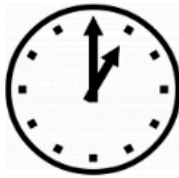

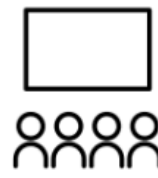
Students who attend every day and are punctual do best

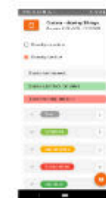
