Weekly Boarding Fees

Weekly Boarding includes 5 nights in residence between Sunday 6 pm and Friday 6 pm. Any time spent in the boarding house outside of these times will be charged at the rate of £88 per night.

6th Form Registration Fee

This payment covers the two day Induction Programme, Sixth Form Planner, Study Skills Workshop, Higher Education/Careers Convention, printer facilities in the Russell Centre and other facilities for Sixth Form students in the Sixth Form Common Room. Payment for this will be collected by ParentPay, a system for parents to make payments for academic expenses to the day school, of which you will be sent full details in August/September.

ACCOUNTS

Billing Period

An invoice for the forthcoming term will be raised and sent during the preceding term, just before the half term holiday. All invoices are to be paid in full within 28 days of the invoice date. For September start, the invoice is issued in May and payment due by end June.

Choice of payment method is included with the Offer Letter, whereby you have the option to pay the invoice in full or pay by three monthly instalments, per term in advance.

We are unable to accept cash, credit or debit cards.

Foreign Currency Transfers

All sums to be collected by the school should be in GB pounds sterling and any costs relating to foreign currency exchange and transfer should be met by the payer.

Security Deposit

Security Deposits will be held in trust by the school and are returnable only upon completion of the student's full course of study which is the three year GCSE course or 2 year A level course and includes sitting all relevant external examinations. UK security deposits will be returned by the school within 6 months of this completion. Overseas security deposits will use £2,000 of the deposit held to offset the final fees invoice and the remaining balance will be returned by the school within 6 months of this completion. Should the student leave the boarding house before the end of their course, the Security Deposit may be retained by the school. The amount returned will be the original Security Deposit less any incurred costs as detailed on the Boarding Entry-Exit Form, or other outstanding expenses.

Notice Period

If a parent/carer withdraws a student from boarding they must give the Head of Boarding one term's notice in writing of their intention to do so by the last day of the previous term. If this notice period is not given in full the parent/carer will be liable for one term's fees in lieu of this notice. Therefore, for example, if a student is going to leave in July and not return in September, the notice must be given before the Easter holidays.
